1. CALL TO ORDER:

3. NEW BUSINESS:

Jim Watson motioned to approve the minutes from the 19 February 2018 meeting, Ken Mitts seconded that motion, and minutes were unanimously approved by all members present.

Golf Course Update: Presented by Sal Garcia, General Manager

- Rounds of golf for February were down significantly for February due to the unusually high number of inclement weather days
 - o February had 11 inclement weather days, the worst February on record for the golf course.
 - o Year to date inclement weather days (October – February) that have limited rounds of golf played.
 - FY 2014 – 26 inclement weather days year to date
 - FY 2015 – 30 inclement weather days year to date
 - FY 2016 – 21 inclement weather days year to date

- FY 2017 – 25 inclement weather days year to date
- FY 2018 – 33 inclement weather days year to date
- Year to date rounds of golf played (October – February)
 - FY 2014 – 10,467 rounds
 - FY 2015 – 9,936 rounds
 - FY 2016 – 10,221 rounds
 - FY 2017 – 10,465 rounds
 - FY 2018 – 9,614 rounds
- Rounds of golf for March 2018 have picked back up and are ahead of March 2017, which highlights the significant correlation between good weather and the willingness of golfers to play the Olympia Hills golf course.
- The course also hosted 6 tournaments the second week of March.
- Sal Garcia also reported progress in recruiting tournament and hole sponsors for the golf cart GPS system.

Events Center Update: Presented by Katie Rein, Food & Beverage Manager)

- Katy Rein reported that beginning in May, the Event Center will have Thursday Night Happy Hours to generate additional food and beverage business.
 - The Thursday Night Happy Hours will run May through June as a trial.
 - If successful, they will be continued.
 - Other ideas are being evaluated to use the Event Center when major events are not planned.

4. OLD BUSINESS:

The committee reviewed the end of FY 2017 financial statements and discussed other options for reviewing current year financial statements on an ongoing basis as they become available from City staff.
