
Brush Disposal and Collection

Universal City provides several avenues to dispose of brush within our City. Some of these options are “no additional charge” and some are “fee-based”. Please be aware that these options have different guidelines which must be followed. Each brush disposal service is explained in the table below. Remember that each homeowner is responsible for the manner in which brush is collected, chipped or disposed. *If you hire a contractor to trim your trees, then you must have the contractor dispose of your brush or you will have to haul it to a landfill.* Information regarding brush disposal and collection is always available on the City web site; visit www.uctx.gov/brush.


| BRUSH DISPOSAL OPTIONS Do NOT place brush in front of parked cars, mailboxes, or on top of meter boxes. NO brush cut or trimmed by contractors will be accepted for any option. NO EXCEPTIONS. | | |

Refer to the reverse side of this flyer to identify your pick up zone Brush pile must be stacked neatly Maximum 8 cubic yards (6'x12'x3') All brush must be at curbside by 7:00 AM on Monday per your zone No Exceptions. If you miss your scheduled collection for your zone; you must choose a different option or remove brush from curb and dispose in a landfill | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Residential and commercial business owners</i> Free brush disposal during City's Annual Spring/Fall Cleanup Events held in April & October of each year (10 days each month) Must show ID or utility bill Must haul brush to Public Works Yard and dispose of brush into containers Event advertised on utility bill, Herald, Gateway and City Website <p style="text-align: center;">Option 2A</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Call Public Works 210-658-5364 to be placed on curbside brush chipping list No chipping in alleys Chip for 30 minutes only No charge during Annual Spring/Fall Cleanup <p>See <u>Brush Pile Guidelines (Option 3)</u> for City Year-Round Curbside Brush Chipping specifications.</p> <p>Free curbside chipping done for <u>10 days</u> only in April & October coinciding with cleanup event dates during regular business hours, M-F, no exceptions.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">If you fail to get on the free April or October brush chipping list, then you must choose a different option to dispose of your brush.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Residential and commercial business owners</i> Curbside chipping only, no alleys Brush chipping performed on Fridays Authorization Form must be completed. <i>Download form or pick up at City Hall or Public Works office. uctx.gov/brush</i> \$30.00 fee per ½ hour (billed in ½ hour increments only) \$60.00 fee up to 1 hour Fees <u>will</u> be added to your utility bill No exceptions. <p style="text-align: center;">BRUSH PILE GUIDELINES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stack brush neatly at curb Limbs 8" in diameter or smaller Limbs 4 feet in length or longer City crew will not chip any limb too short in length as this is dangerous to our employees <p><i>We do <u>not</u> brush chip the following:</i> Bamboo, banana plants, cactus, lumber, palm tree leaves/bark, vines, thorny bushes, or stumps/roots.</p> |

Visual Representation of Eight (8) Cubic Yards


