See height requirements determined by pitch. All four above pictured caps are UL listed and bear that stamp usually along the base.

## Forced exhaust vents (i.e. bathroom/laundry exhaust, clothes dryer, kitchen hood)



These vents come equipped with a backdraft damper and screen. For installation in bathroom/laundry exhaust or kitchen hood the screen should remain to deter pests and birds. For installation as part of a clothes dryer exhaust the screen should be removed to prevent lint build up that can cause fires.



\*Disclaimer: Roof exhaust vents are determined by the manufacturer's specifications for each appliance. It is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure the correct vent installed meets the manufacturer's specifications and all connections are maintained from the discharge of the appliance to the point of termination.
